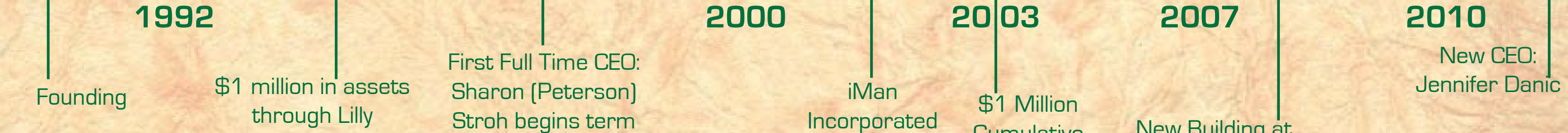
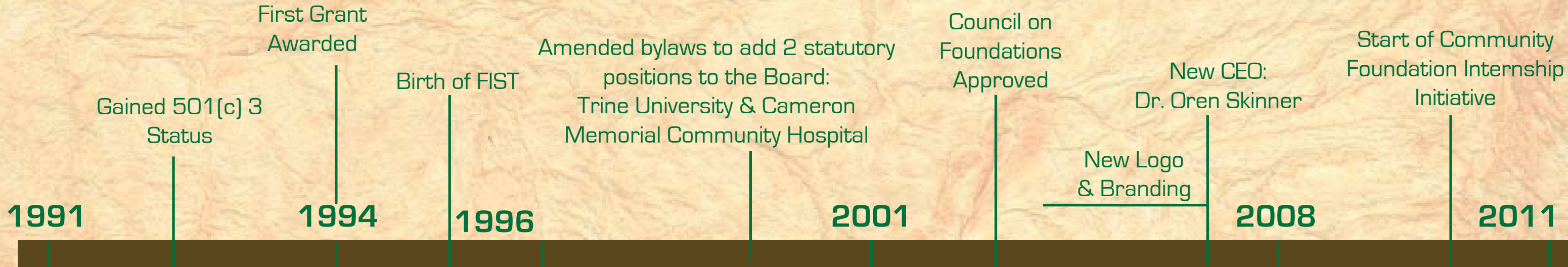

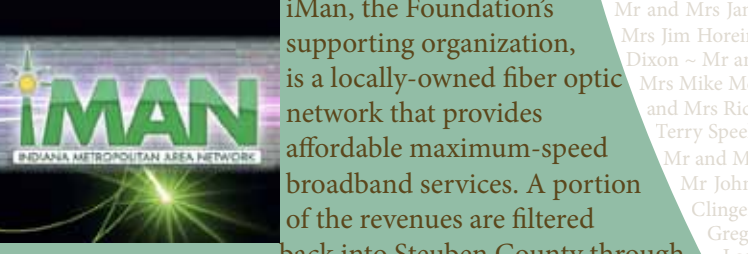

Since 1991, the Foundation's supporting organization, iMan, is a locally-owned fiber optic network that provides affordable maximum-speed broadband services. A portion of the revenues are filtered back into Steuben County through the Steuben County Community Foundation. Since 2004, iMan has returned \$42,350 through the Foundation back into the community. 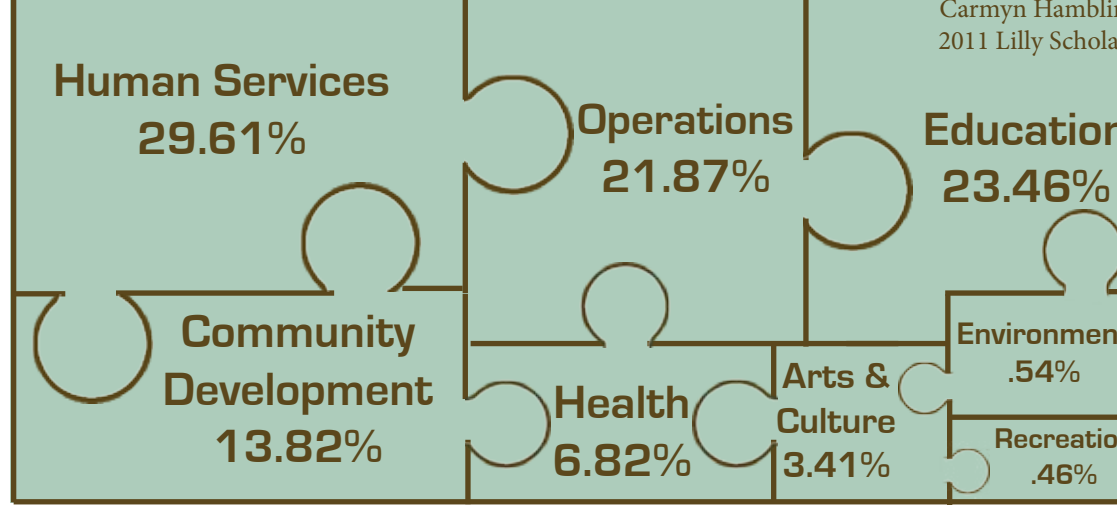
