### **Requirements**

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident.
- The student(s) must be currently enrolled or planning to attend, part time or full time, Ivy Tech State College.
- Attachments requested are provided along with the application.
- Financial need will be considered, but will not be the sole criteria for selection.

### **Selection committee:**

- Family members take an active role in the selection process and award presentation.
- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee

### **Miscellaneous:**

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- The student may reapply (but must have a 2.0 minimum GPA).
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Snyder Ivy Tech State College Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.

*\*NOTE: Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Snyder family.*
