Requirements:

- The recipient(s) must be a resident of Steuben, Lagrange or Dekalb counties in Indiana.
- Scholarship is open to a traditional student (high school graduating senior) or a non-traditional student (returning back after an absence since graduating from high school) or any student who is home schooled or has earned a GED.
- The recipient(s) must enroll in an Indiana state accredited school of higher education, trade school, certificate or degree program.
- Scholarship may be used for tuition, room & board, fees, supplies, or any other class-required expenses.
- Any student may re-apply for the annual award so long as they maintain satisfactory status.

Award

- The amount of the award per student will be determined each year based on the amount available.
- If they so choose, the selection committee may determine to award multiple, smaller awards rather than one scholarship award.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Las Limas Community Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the requirements above can be made at the request of and with the approval of the selection committee.
