



The Cheryl Anstett Scholarship

In October of 2007, Cheryl Anstett, a retired public school teacher, created this scholarship to help students who have been out of school more than one year and are interested in continuing their education. This scholarship gives non-traditional students an opportunity to apply for assistance. Non-traditional can be described in a variety of ways such as those who have earned a GED instead of a high school diploma, home-schooled students, and those who have been out of school for more than one year.

Cheryl had started her career in education as a teacher's aide at Pleasant Lake Elementary School. Upon support and prodding of her principal, Cheryl began taking classes at Tri State University leading to a degree in elementary teaching. Cheryl completed a long term teaching career at Prairie Heights Community School Corporation. Cheryl created the scholarship to help those students that have been out of high school for a period of time and who had similar experiences to her own.

Requirements:

- The recipient(s) must be a graduate of one of the four high schools serving Steuben County having been out of school for one or more years or a non-traditional student (home schooled or GED certificate holder from Steuben County).
- The recipient(s) must attend an Indiana institution of higher education (trade or technical school, two-year institution or four year institution).
- Scholarship may be used for tuition, room & board, fees, supplies, or any other class-required expenses.

Selection Committee:

- Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee

Award

- The amount of the award per student will be determined each year based on the amount available.
- If they so choose, the selection committee may determine to award multiple, smaller awards rather than one scholarship award.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution of higher learning to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Cheryl Anstett Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.

NOTE: Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of the donor, and with the approval of the Steuben County Community Foundation Board.
