Ed Haas was 37 years old when in 1988 he died as a result of an auto accident with a drunk driver. Ed loved children, and so after his untimely death, family and friends felt it befitting that a memorial scholarship in his name would be something that would have made him happy. The Ed Haas Memorial Scholarship was established.

Haas was born in Bellevue, Ohio and graduated from Manchester College in Manchester, IN. He was a teacher at Hendry Park Elementary, an organist at the Angola United Methodist Church, and a waiter at the Lake James Golf Course. He had also taught for 10 years at Carlin Park Elementary and at Pleasant Lake Elementary School.

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Ed Haas Memorial Scholarship, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
