- The student(s) must be enrolled at Trine University. They may be a high school graduating senior, a non-traditional student, or a student currently enrolled at Trine.
- The student(s) must be pursuing a bachelor's degree in the area of Environmental Science
- Recipient must agree to attend a Board Meeting of the NISWMD within 3 months of accepting this scholarship.
- Attachments requested are to be provided with the application.

Selection committee:

- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee
- Members of the NISWMD staff, Citizen's Advisory Board, and/or the board of director's may be participants in the selection process.

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the NISWMD Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the NISWMD.
