Established in 2006 by friends and family of Richard (Dick) L. Baker this scholarship provides support to a graduating senior from Fremont High School.

A 1950 graduate of Fremont High School, Dick attended college, served in the army, and came back to Fremont Community Schools in 1966 when he became a Fremont Elementary teacher. He taught for 25 years until his retirement in 1992. Dick shared his love of the land and farming with Steuben County residents when in 1968 he opened the Baker's Acres Farm Market. It was a place where many Steuben County students remember making class field trips or family trips, especially at Halloween time when elaborate holiday displays that included ghosts and goblins were made from homegrown vegetables.

Requirements:

- The student must be a graduating senior from Fremont High School.
- The student must live within the Fremont Community School District.
- The student must be admitted to a college or university as a full-time student.
- The student must receive an Academic Honors Diploma from Fremont High School.
- Required attachments include:
 1. 250 word essay
 2. high school transcript

Selection Committee:

- Fremont Classroom Teachers Association
- Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee

Award

- The amount of the award per student will be determined each year based on the amount available.
- If they so choose, the selection committee may determine to award multiple, smaller awards rather than one scholarship award.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Richard L. Baker Memorial Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of and with the approval of the selection committee.
- The scholarship can be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board or other school related expenses.
- Applications can be turned in to the Steuben County Community Foundation office located at 207 S. Wayne, Suite A, Angola, IN. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday or to a Fremont High School guidance counselor.
