Requirements:

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident
- The student(s) must be graduating or have graduated from any Steuben County high school, a non-traditional student (returning back after an absence since graduating from high school or seeking to complete a bachelor's degree), or an adult pursuing post-graduate studies.
- The student(s) must be planning to attend any type of post-secondary education in any state.
- Student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 or better
- Financial need will be a consideration
- Student's involvement in volunteer and extra curricular activities will be a consideration
- An essay is required
- Three letters of recommendation are required

Selection Process:

- Selection is made by the Steuben County Community Foundation's Scholarship Committee, members of the Bauer, Roe, Weaver and Zimmer families.

Award:

- Preference will be given to Angola High School students who graduated in 2011 or who will graduate in 2012.
- A minimum of one award will go to an Angola High School graduate from the class of 2011.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- Recipients may re-apply and will be considered along with other applications received.

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Fourever Friends 2011 Memorial Scholarship, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Steuben County Community Foundation.
