



The Dr. M.G. “Doc” Headley Scholarship

Dr. M. G. “Doc” Headley, was a popular Steuben County civic leader who amused thousands over the years with his calliope, organs and antique farm equipment. He was a man who brought joy to others with what brought joy to him. Doc was a well-known veterinarian in the community, locating in Angola after his graduation from Ohio State University in 1958. In the early 1980s, he established the Grandview Veterinary Clinic in Angola. He was known for never turning away an animal in need of treatment, despite an owner’s inability to pay. Many recognized Doc because of his appearances in local parades and for bringing Santa Claus to town in his fire-truck with a mounted calliope. In earlier days, he was an avid aviator and had served as the president of the Steuben County Board of Aviation Commissioners since its inception. After his death in 2000, his wife established the educational scholarship as an ongoing and living memorial.

The Dr. M.G. “Doc” Headley Scholarship

Requirements:

- The students must be pursuing a certified or degreed agricultural or veterinarian program at an institution of higher education. This includes both university and trade school programs.
- NOTE: special consideration will be given to those students in the field of veterinary medicine.
- There are no restrictions as to how many times the student may apply for the scholarship during his/her educational career.
- The student must be graduating from Angola, Fremont, Hamilton or Prairie Heights High School.

Selection Committee: Minimum of three persons.

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the M. G. “Doc” Headley Scholarship fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Headley family.
