The Giles F. & Rose A. Heroy Scholarship for Teaching is a four-year renewable scholarship that is awarded to a graduating senior from a Steuben County High School and/or the child of a current Angola Wire Employee regardless of their residency. The student should be enrolling in an institution of higher education to study education, library science, or plan on teaching in his/her chosen field. The Heroy family believes this scholarship to be a most appropriate memorial to their parents.

The Giles F. & Rose A. Heroy Scholarship for Teaching

Requirements:

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident or the child of a current Angola Wire Products employee.
- The student(s) must be a graduating senior from any Steuben County high school.
Note: All graduating seniors will be given consideration. Children of current Angola Wire Products employees (regardless of residency), will be given preferential consideration.
- The student(s) must be pursuing a degree in education, library science, or plan to teach in their chosen field.
- Attachments requested are provided along with the application.

Selection Committee:

- Heroy family members take an active role in the selection process and award presentation.
- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation.

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Giles F. & Rose A. Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Heroy family.
- This scholarship is renewable for up to 4 years to recipients in good standing with their college or university.
