Requirements:

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident
- The student(s) must be a graduating senior from MSD of Steuben County.
- The student(s) must be admitted to a 4 year university or college.
- Attachments requested are provided along with the application.
- The student should have at least a 3.0 GPA in a four-point grading system.

Selection Process:

- Selection is made by the Steuben County Community Foundation's Scholarship Committee.

Award:

- One time award. Additional awards may be lesser amounts, based on amount available. The student(s) may **reapply** each year and will be given preference as long as a 3.0 GPA is maintained and financial need is demonstrated.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Harry W. Kelley Memorial Scholarship, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Kelley family.
