After graduating from Angola High School, she continued her education at Michigan State University. While there she received a Rotary Foundation Fellow Scholarship and went to Paris, France, to study for one year. Returning to the U.S., she enrolled at the University of Wisconsin where she earned a Master's Degree. Sylvia went on to work for the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). After completing her training, she was sent to work in Morocco where she stayed until she became ill and returned to the United States.

The Sylvia E. Jackson Scholarship - MSD

Requirements:

- The student to be considered must reside in Steuben County and be enrolled as a senior in Angola High School on or before October 1 of their senior year.
- The recipient of the scholarship must attend an accredited school within the boundaries of the United States. The program may vary from a one-year program upwards.
- The criteria that will be used in reviewing the applications is academic achievement, academic potential and general citizenship. Other factors may be considered, but are not as important as those mentioned.

Selection committee: Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses. The award is sent to the school to be placed in the student's account.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Sylvia E. Jackson Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of the Metropolitan School District of Steuben County or the Klink Family.
