The Gene E. Kalb Student Scholarship

Requirements:

- The recipient(s) must be a Steuben County resident.
- The recipient(s) must have graduated from Angola, Fremont, Hamilton, or Prairie Heights high schools.
- Scholarship is open to a traditional student (high school graduating senior) or a non-traditional student (returning back after an absence since graduating from high school).
- The recipient(s) must **attend an Indiana institution** of higher education.
- Scholarship may be used for tuition, room & board, fees, supplies, or any other class-required expenses.
- Attachments requested are provided along with the application.
 - **Essay:** Answer the question “ *How do you feel you can contribute to the community you live in?*”

Selection Committee:

- Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee

Award:

- The amount of the award per student will be determined each year based on the amount available.
- If they so choose, the selection committee may determine to award multiple, smaller awards rather than one scholarship award.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university to be deposited into the recipient’s account.

Miscellaneous:

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Gene Kalb Student Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of and with the approval of the selection committee.
