



The “Not Your Ordinary Student” Scholarship

In February of 2007, the Steuben County Community Foundation Board of Directors created the “Not Your Ordinary Student” Scholarship that will provide scholarship assistance to residents of Steuben County in a non-traditional way. This scholarship gives non-traditional students an opportunity to apply for assistance. Non-traditional can be described in a variety of ways such as those who have earned a GED instead of a high school diploma, home-schooled students, and those who have been out of school for awhile (with or without college credit).

The “Not Your Ordinary Student” Scholarship

Requirements:

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident
- Applying for higher education after receiving a GED
- Applying for higher education after having been home-schooled
- Student returning to higher education after an absence in traditional forms of school; with or without some college credit (i.e. re-entry)
- Or any other non-traditional student

Selection committee:

- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the “Not Your Ordinary Student” Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.

NOTE: Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Steuben County Community Foundation Board.
