Requirements:

- The student must have graduated from Angola, Hamilton, Fremont or Prairie Heights High Schools.
- The student must have completed 7 years in the 4-H program.
- The student must be enrolled as a member of the Steuben county 4-H program in the spring of the year in which the award is presented.
- The student must be entering or have completed his/her freshman year in an 18-month to four-year program at an institution of higher education, as long as they are in 4-H that year.
*** Note: Special consideration will be made to those students in the field of Agriculture.*
- Location of institution of higher education is limited to the state of Indiana.

Selection criteria:

- The predominant basis of the scholarship will be the student's achievement in 4-H and financial need.
- Required attachments are included with application.

Selection committee: (MUST be a minimum of five members)

- Member(s) of the Rensch family
- Representative(s) of the Fair Board
- Representative of the Community Foundation
- Representative of the Extension Office

Miscellaneous:

- Award to be presented during each year's 4-H fair.
- If they so choose, the selection committee may determine to award multiple, smaller awards rather than one scholarship award.
