



The Steven “Chad” Shively Memorial Scholarship

Steven and Deniese Shively, in memory of their son and as a living memorial, established the Steven “Chad” Shively Memorial Scholarship. Chad, at age 22, had a great start in his career as a farmer until June, 2001 when a hay-baling accident cut his life tragically short. Chad, a 1996 Fremont High School graduate, was a 10-year 4-H member and owner of the C&J Club Calves in Fremont, a ranch with about 30 herd of cattle. He enjoyed working with animals, hunting, fishing, riding four-wheelers, and “helping any kid with their cattle.”

The Steven “Chad” Shively Memorial Scholarship

Requirements:

- The student must be a graduating senior from Angola, Fremont, Hamilton or Prairie Heights high school.
- The student must be entering or have completed his/her freshman year in an 18-month to four-year program at an institution of higher education.
- The student must have participated in 4-H for a minimum of five (5) years and be enrolled in a 4-H project in the Spring of the year the award is presented. NOTE: Special consideration will be given to those students having shown an interest in livestock during their 4-H career.

Selection criteria:

- The predominant basis of the scholarship will be the student’s achievement in 4-H. A copy of their 4-H Record of Achievement is to be included with the application.
- Student should include an essay of up to 200 words on how 4-H has influenced them.

Selection committee:

- Member(s) of the Shively family
- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee
- Minimum of three persons

Miscellaneous:

- Award to be presented during each year’s 4-H fair.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Steven Chad Shively Scholarship fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of and with the approval of the Shively family.
- If they so choose, the selection committee may determine to award multiple, smaller awards rather than one scholarship award.
