The Diana Kay Smith Memorial Scholarship

Requirements:

- The student must be a senior girl graduating from Fremont High School.
- The student must have participated in band, music or vocal programs at Fremont High School.
- Two references are needed. Please attach to application
- Attach copy of school transcripts to application
- Attach to the application required essay.

Selection process:

- Selection is made by the Steuben County Community Foundation's Scholarship Committee and member(s) of the Smith family.

Award:

- Award is for tuition only.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the school chosen by the recipient.
- The recipient is eligible to reapply.

**NOTE: Special consideration will be those students accepted to attend Trine University.*

Miscellaneous:

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Diana Kay Smith Scholarship, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Smith family.
